MODI

WAR

In Manipur, the war heroes were remembered at a programme in Imphal which was attended by Governor, Ajay kumar Bhalla and DGP Rajiv Singh. Addressing the event, Governor, Ajay kumar Bhalla paid heartfelt

tributes to the brave soldiers who made the supreme sacrifice for the country.

TRIPURA

Tripura Chief Minister, Manik Saha has asserted that the State Government has undertaken several ambitious projects and schemes for the all-round development of the tribals, who constitute one third of the state's four million population. Felicitating meritorious students in a programme, Chief Minister refuted the accusation of a financial crunch in the Tripura Tribal Areas Autonomous District Council while informing that the state government has undertaken an Rs 1,400 crore World Bank aided project dedicated exclusively to the development of tribal areas. In addition to Central-sponsored programmes, the Chief Minister pointed out that various initiatives have been taken to improve education, healthcare, road connectivity and drinking water supply in tribal inhabited areas.

ARMS

In Manipur, security forces continue to crackdown on illegal arms hoarders. In another major crackdown, Manipur Police along with CAPFs conducted search operation in different districts and recovered 90 illegal arms along with huge cache of ammunition and explosives. Addressing a press conference, IGP (Intelligence) of Manipur Police, K. Kabib said that the cordon and search operation was conducted in Imphal East, Imphal West, Thoubal, Kakching and Bishnupur districts by the combined security forces The recovered weapons included AK rifles, M16, INSAS LMG, INSAS rifle, SLR, 303 rifles beside other items.

The 134th edition of the Durand Cup was kicked off at the Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium in Shillong on Saturday in front of thousands of cheering football fans. The event marked the return of Asia's oldest football tournament to the hill city for the second consecutive year. The opening ceremony featured a rich blend of culture and tradition, with musical performances and amazing displays. Following the ceremonial kick-off, the opening Group E match was played between local favourites Shillong Lajong FC and Malaysian Armed Forces The visitors were trounced 6-0 by Shillong Lajong FC in the match. Buam scored two goals each, while Treimiki Lamurong and Deibormame Tongper added one a piece to complete the thrashing.
