The Chief Justice of the Gauhati High Court, Justice Ashutosh Kumar paid a courtesy visit to Governor Lt. General K.T. Parnaik (Retd.) at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar today. During the meeting, Justice Kumar extended a formal invitation to the Governor to grace the Silver Jubilee celebrations of the Gauhati High Court's Itanagar Permanent Bench. The Governor congratulated the Chief Justice on the establishment of the new state-of-the-art court building for the Itanagar Permanent Bench, describing it as a milestone in strengthening the delivery of justice in the State.

Governor Lt. General K.T. Parnaik (Retd.) today presented the 'Governor's Medallion for Excellence' to Director, NIMAS Dirang, Col. R.S. Jamwal for his outstanding contributions to adventure activities in Arunachal Pradesh. In an interaction at Raj Bhawan, Itanagar, the Director briefed the Governor about the activities of NIMAS, including the Brahmaputra River Rafting Expedition and Mount Kanchenjunga Expedition. While congratulating the NIMAS Director on the remarkable success, the Governor asked the Director to initiate more adventure activities involving local youth.

Chief Secretary, Manish Kumar today held a meeting with VSM, Chief of Staff, HQ 4 Corps, Maj. Gen. HS Bajaj and Nodal Officer for the Rashtra Nirman: Veteran Se Sanjhedari initiative in Arunachal Pradesh. The event will feature games such as featuring Boxing, Taekwondo, and Weightlifting (U-17 Boys & Girls).
