Prime Minister Narendra Modi will share his thoughts in the Mann Ki Baat program on All India Radio tomorrow at 11 am. This will be the 125th episode of this monthly radio program. The program will be broadcast live on the entire network of All India Radio and Doordarshan, the website of All India Radio News and the News on Mobile App. It will also be broadcast live on the YouTube channels of All India Radio News, Doordarshan News, Prime Minister's Office and Ministry of Information and Broadcasting.

Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla has called for setting up committees of state legislatures on the welfare of the scheduled castes and scheduled tribes in all the states and union territories. Speaking at the valedictory session of the two-day National Conference of Chairpersons of the Committees of Parliament and State Legislatures on the Welfare of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes at Bhubaneswar today, Mr Birla said the Parliament Committee must recommend for such committees in the states.

As part of the 3-day National Sports Day celebration and to promote physical fitness, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt. General Retd KT Parnaik, today participated in the badminton game at Rajiv Gandhi University, Rono Hills, Doimukh. Speaking on the occasion, Governor said that the youth of Arunachal Pradesh are bringing glory to the State and the nation with their remarkable achievements at both the national and international levels. He emphasized the need for systematic talent scouting, to nurture the potential of the young generation of the state. The Governor, reminding India's bid to host the Commonwealth Games in 2030 and the Olympic Games in 2036, urged the youth of the State, particularly budding sportspersons, to prepare themselves with dedication and determination.

State Chief Secretary Manish Kumar Gupta along with Commissioner WCD & Handicrafts Mimum Tayeng, Secretary Skill Development Bullo Mamu and Deputy Director ICDS Machi Gao today visited Oju Welfare Association (OWA) at B' Sector in Naharlagun. The Chief Secretary and the Commissioners took a tour of various Oju run

establishments. They also visited cutting & tailoring Vocational centre. Further, the Chief Secretary distributed the certificates to passing out 9th batch students. He also interacted with the students. In his address, he urged for vocational trainings which has potential in Arunachal Pradesh and can generate more employment and increase in income. Later, the Chief Secretary proceeded for Oju Mission School at Papu Nallah. A two point memorandum for reintroduction of Embroidery and beauty parlour courses for women was presented to the Chief Secretary. Further, he also planted a sapling under 'Ek Ped Maa ke Naam' in the school campus.

Arunachal Chief Minister Pema Khandu took stock of the progress of The Hunli-Hayuliang route of the Frontier Highway. Sharing the news on a social media post he said, once completed the highway will not only open new horizons for tourism but also provide a strong strategic link, connecting Lower Dibang Valley with Lohit and Anjaw, strengthening national security. He was joined by Minister of Land Management Balo Raja, Chief Secretary Manish Kumar Gupta, PCCF, and MLA Tezu, Dr Mohesh Chai joined through VC.

Chief Minister Pema Khandu reviewed preparations for the Third North East Aviation Summit along with Minister Balo Raja. On a social media post the CM shared that on 4th September in Itanagar, will work on a roadmap to strengthen the aviation sector and create real opportunities for the people of the Northeast.

Taking note that Protected cultivation of high-value crops using low-cost structures of Polyhouses is beneficial for farmers in hill regions, ICAR-Vivekananda Parvatiya Krishi Anusandhan Sansthan, Almora (Uttarakhand), under the North Eastern Hill programme, in collaboration with Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Tawang, visited Khinmey and Gyangkhar villages on 27th and 28th August 2025 to monitor the performance of the 30 VL Portable Polyhouses they had distributed to progressive vegetable-growing farmers last year. During ineteraction the farmers expressed enthusiasm towards protected cultivation. A total of 30 farmers from both villages participated.

The Meteorological Centre Itanagar has issued an orange alert for Papumpare district of Arunachal Pradesh. MCI has predicted that thunderstorm with lightning and very Heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places. Additionally, a yellow alert has also been issued for eighteen districts of Arunachal Pradesh.

India's real Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is estimated to grow by 7.8 per cent in April to June quarter of financial year 2025-26, at a five-quarter high. In the fourth quarter of the last financial year, the GDP had grown by 7.4 per cent, whereas the same stood at 6.5 per cent in the first quarter of previous fiscal year. According to the Quarterly Estimates of GDP for first Quarter of current fiscal released by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, Nominal GDP has witnessed a growth rate of 8.8 per cent in during the same period. Agriculture and allied sectors have seen Real Gross Value Added growth rate. Among Secondary Sectors, Manufacturing and Construction are estimated to grow.
