State Minister of Women & Child Welfare, Dasanglu Pul today called on the Governor Lt. General KT Parnaik (Retd.), at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar. They discussed strengthening women's empowerment, promoting women-led entrepreneurship, advancing childcare initiatives, and accelerating the implementation of the Vibrant Village Program. The Governor emphasized that true progress can only be achieved when women are at the heart of development. He highlighted the need to create greater opportunities for women to become job creators and leaders through skill development, access to markets, and support for local products under the 'Vocal for Local' initiative. He noted that women-led entrepreneurship is not just an economic strategy but a way to build stronger, self-reliant communities.

Governor Lt. General KT Parnaik (Retd.), yesterday unveiled the Commemorative Pillar of the Golden Jubilee Celebration of the State Legislative Assembly, in the Assembly Complex, Itanagar. He also visited the photo exhibition displaying the photographic records of the Assembly's rich history. On the occasion, the Governor felicitated former Chief Ministers, Speakers and Deputy Speakers.

Chief Minister Pema Khandu today convened the 4th meeting of the 24th State Board for Wildlife at Itanagar. The meeting deliberated on ways to address forest-related issues with care, with respect and with cultural sensitivity. In a social media post Khandu emphasised that, protecting the forests is important, but protecting the people who have called these forests home for generations is just as vital. In the meantime, the CM has urged the Forest Department to approach its work with sensitivity.

The Government of Arunachal Pradesh and the residents of Beking Village in Siang District today signed a Memorandum of Understanding for the conduct of the Pre-Feasibility Report of the Siang Upper Multipurpose Project. The MoU was signed in the presence of Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein, Minister of RD & PR, Ojing Tasing, Advisor Ninong Ering, Chairman of Siang Upper Multipurpose Project Development Committee, Tamiyo Taga and

other Officials. In a social media post, Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein emphasised that the signing of the MOU is a reaffirmation of the State Governments approach to development based on dialogue, consent, and shared responsibility. By signing the MOU, more than 85% of the households of Begging village have pledged their irrevocable support for preparation of the PFR of the SUMP, stated a release.

Minister for Urban Development, Balo Raja along with IMC Mayor, Tamme Phassang, inspected the upcoming Waste-to-Charcoal Plant at the city dumping ground. Speaking to the media, Mayor Tamme Phassang informed that IMC have partnered with a private company that will process the garbage and convert it into charcoal. The Mayor additionally informed that the entire funding for the project will be undertaken by the company while the IMC's responsibility will be to provide basic infrastructure such as electricity supply, approach roads, and security walls. Meanwhile, Minister Balo Raja also assured full support from the Urban Local Bodies to IMC in facilitating the project.

A series of sericulture awareness campaign in the state was launched at Linka village of Ruksin circle in East Siang district yesterday. Organised by the Central Muga Eri Research & Training Institute, Jorhat, the programme is a part of the countrywide campaign initiated by the Ministry of Textile under its 'Mera Resham, Mera Abhiman' mission. The programme aims to motivate Muga, Eri and Silk rearers of the country. About 35 muga and eri-silk farmers of the area participated in the day-long awareness programme.

The Meteorological Centre Itanagar has issued a yellow alert for fifteen districts in Arunachal Pradesh. MCI has predicted thunderstorm with lightning and heavy rain very likely at isolated places.

The Indian Army will be conducting Agniveer Recruitment Rally for shortlisted candidates of Arunachal Pradesh under the aegis of Army Recruiting Office, Jorhat at Gyaptong Regional Stadium, Rupa from 3rd to 5th September next. The shortlisted candidates will be required to report at Marshalling Area, Gyaptong Regional Stadium, Rupa at 02:30 AM on the 3rd of September.
