Addressing the nation this evening, Mr Modi said GST Bachat Utsav will begin from tomorrow and people can buy their choice of goods at a lesser price. He added that nation's growth story will be changed with these reforms and youth, neo middle class, farmers, women, and entrepreneurs will greatly benefit from this Bachat Utsav. He highlighted that every state will be an equal partner in the journey of nation's development. He extended his greetings to the nation for the next gen GST reforms, Bachat Utsav and Navratri.

Byte::PM on GST Reforms

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will visit Itanagar tomorrow during which he is scheduled to lay the foundation stones for two hydroelectric power projects worth over Rs 3,700 crore, and 10 other infrastructure projects worth Rs 1,291 crore. The two power projects include the 186 MW Tato Hydroelectric Project and the 240 MW Heo Hydroelectric Project; both located in Shi Yomi District. These projects are expected to boost the state's power generation capacity and support local development. Security in the capital city Itanagar has been heightened ahead of the PM's visit. The event will be attended by prominent dignitaries including Governor Lt Gen K.T. Parnaik (Retd), Chief Minister Pema Khandu, Union Minister Kiren Rijiju, Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein, Lok Sabha MP Tapir Gao, and Rajya Sabha MP Nabam Rebia.

Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein flagged off the Namo Yuva Run – For a Nasha Mukt Bharat at Itanagar today. The marathon witnessed enthusiastic participation of more than 7,000 youths from across Arunachal Pradesh. DCM Mein in a social media post informed that, the run was part of a nationwide campaign launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, being held simultaneously across 100 cities with the participation of over 10 lakh young Indians. He further informed that the 5 km marathon is not just about fitness but also about spreading awareness on the dangers of substance abuse, inspiring our youth to adopt healthy lifestyles, and strengthening the

call for a drug-free nation. Ministers, Kento Jini, Dasanglu Pul, State BJP President, Kaling Moyong and others attended the program.

As part of the ongoing Seva Pakhwada, the Central Bureau of Communication, Regional Office Itanagar along with its five Field Offices at Tawang, Bomdila, Aalo, Pasighat and Tezu organized a plantation drive under the theme Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam. The 5th State Level Judo Championship 2025 was inaugurated yesterday at the Khelo India Indoor Hall, Raga, Kamle District. A total

of 160 players from 19 districts are competing across four age divisions—Sub-Junior, Cadet, Junior, and Senior covering 50 weight categories, with support from 25 officials. The tournament will continue till September 22.

India's Anand kumar Velkumar clinched gold in the men's 42km marathon and made history at the 2025 World Speed Skating Championships in China. He won two golds and a bronze. It is his third medal at the ongoing event.
