Prime Minister Narendra Modi today inaugurated and laid the foundation stone of multiple development projects worth over 34,200 crore rupees at 'Samudra se Samriddhi', including major maritime projects worth over 7,800 crore rupees event in Bhavnagar. Prime Minister also virtually dedicated 21 MoUs worth 66,000 crores rupees of Ministry of Port and shipping. Addressing the occasion, Prime Minister Narendra Modi called for self-reliance in every field, asserting that India's dependence on foreign countries remains one of its biggest enemies. He said it is high time that India stands before the world as a self-reliant nation to realise the vision of a developed India by 2047. Mr. Modi inaugurating Mumbai International Cruise Terminal, announced that the India's maritime sector would soon adopt a "One Nation, One Port Procedure," aiming to simplify port procedures across the country. Underscoring India's civilizational maritime legacy, PM Modi said the government is establishing a National Maritime Heritage Museum at Lothal to showcase the country's ancient maritime traditions and preserve them for future generations.

Chief Secretary Manish Kumar Gupta yesterday chaired the State Level Census Coordination Committee meeting for Census 2027 in Arunachal Pradesh in the presence of Ankur Garg, Commissioner Economic & Statistics, Dr. Pooja Pandey, Director of Census Operations, and others. They reviewed the preparations and discussed the use of digital methods, training of staff etc. The Census will begin on 1st March 2027 and will be India's first ever 100 percent digital census.

Chief Minister Pema Khandu yesterday convened the 3rd High-Level Task Force Meeting on self-reliance in milk, egg, fish & meat, focusing on empowering farmers, creating sustainable livelihoods, and positioning the North East as a driver of Atmanirbhar Bharat. Union Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia, Ministry of DoNER Team, state government officials of Tripura, Nagaland and Manipur participated via video conference. Discussion were held on building sustainable value chains, strengthening local production capacities and fostering

collaboration across all North Eastern states to ensure nutritional security and economic growth for the region.

Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein today inspected the ongoing ground preparation works at Indira Gandhi Park, Itanagar, ahead of the visit of Prime Minister Narendra Modi on 22nd September. In a social media post DCM shared, special focus is given to security, seating, stage setup, public convenience and overall preparedness to make the event smooth, safe and memorable for the people of Arunachal Pradesh. The inspection was carried out along with the District Administration, senior Government officials and representatives from NEEPCO. Chief Minister Pema Khandu also inspected the preparations yesterday.

Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein today joined Arunachal Pradesh BJP in celebrating Seva Pakhwada at Itanagar, Energy Park (IG Park). As part of "Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam," DCM Mein planted a sapling and attended exhibitions on PM Modi's life, highlighting campaigns like Fit India Movement, Swachh Bharat and more. Seva Pakhwada, being observed nationwide from 17th September for 15 days, is a people's campaign of service with health check-ups, cleanliness drives, blood donation, plantation, and community outreach at its core.
