President Droupadi Murmu has said that providing the best possible education to daughters is the most effective way to promote women-led development. Addressing the gathering after presenting the National Teachers Awards 2025 in New Delhi on the occasion of Teacher's Day today, the President emphasized that girls' education should be accorded the highest priority. She added that investment in daughters' education is a priceless contribution to the development of families, society, and the nation. The President expressed happiness that the Gross Enrollment Ratio of girls in higher education has shown a significant rise in recent years. President Murmu highlighted that the National Education Policy 2020 lays special emphasis on making education more accessible and seamless at the school level.

Housing and Urban Affairs Minister Manohar Lal has launched Angikaar 2025 campaign under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban 2.0. The campaign is an outreach programme, which will accelerate the implementation of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban by creating widespread awareness about the scheme across the country. It will also fast-track verification of applications under the scheme and expedite the completion of already sanctioned houses.

Governor Lt. General KT Parnaik (Retd.), today presented the State Awards for Teachers at the Golden Jubilee Banquet Hall, Itanagar. A total of 40 educators, including Principals, a Headmistress, PGTs, TGTs, PETs, and PRTs, were honoured for their outstanding contributions to the advancement of education in the State. The awardees represented both government and government-aided private schools. The Governor congratulated the award winners and said that the recognition for their sincere service to education and also a source of inspiration to nurture a generation equipped with knowledge, values, and wisdom.

Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein today congratulated Headmistress Nang Ekthani Mounglang, of Govt. Secondary School Pachin, Papum Pare for being honoured with the National Teachers Award 2025 by President Droupadi Murmu. In a social media post, Mein informed that under her guidance, the school achieved a milestone raising Class X CBSE results from 27% in 2023 to 100%

in 2025, making it the first government school in the state capital to accomplish this feat. Her initiatives, including ICT-integrated classrooms, co-curricular programs, and active community engagement, have transformed the school into a model of holistic development in line with NEP 2020, Mein added.

MLA Nabam Vivek today inaugurated a newly refurbished auditorium, "Haakum Hapa Nam" at the Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Awasiya Vidyalaya, Yupia. The once-unused hall has been transformed into a 125-seater modern auditorium by the District Administration under the supervision of Deputy Commissioner Vishakha Yadav. The facility will cater to the needs of students for extra-curricular activities, cultural events, and academic meetings. On the occasion, the DC announced the launch of a new initiative, the "Teacher of the Month Award," to recognize outstanding educators. The inaugural award was conferred to Amen Takio, PRT, Government Residential School Nyopang, Mengio block.

Tomo Riba Institute of Health & Medical Sciences (TRIHMS) Naharlagun and North Eastern Regional Institute of Science & Technology (NERIST) Nirjuli have signed a Memorandum of Understanding to promote cooperation in academics, research, innovation, training and student/faculty exchange programs. The partnership is designed to leverage the complementary strengths of the two institutions; medical sciences and engineering & technology to address local challenges in healthcare.

The Government of Arunachal Pradesh has issued a directive to ensure strict compliance with the conditions prescribed under the Pharmacy Act, 1948. As per the directives, only individuals who are registered pharmacists in Arunachal Pradesh (or approved under section 14) are entitled to practice pharmacy in the state. No person other than a Registered Pharmacist shall compound, prepare, mix or dispense medicines on the prescription of a medical practitioner. Dispensing by unqualified persons is strictly prohibited. All Heads of Institutions/Organizations in Govt. & Private sectors are hereby urged to comply within 6 months of issue of the memorandum.

A 10-Days Special Awareness Campaigns under SANKALP: HEW( Hub for Empowerment of Women) on women-centric themes is currently underway in Papumpare district and will continue till 12th sept next. As a part of the campaign, special awareness and capacity building on all women centric schemes, such as One Stop Centre (OSC), (Women Helpline (WHL), Child Helpline (CHL), Shakti

Sadan, Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandhana Yojana (PMMVY) for vegetable vendors at Nyorch market were organized. Similarly, awareness on POSH Act (Sexual Harassment of women at work place) was given to the women employees under District Administration Yupia.
