Prime Minister Narendra Modi today launched the nationwide Swasth Nari, Sashakt Parivar Abhiyaan, and the 8th Rashtriya Poshan Maah camping from Dhar in Madhya Pradesh. The Swasth Nari Sashakt Parivar Abhiyaan is a landmark initiative by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and the Ministry of Women and Child Development, aimed at strengthening healthcare services for women and children across India, with a focus on improving access, quality care, and awareness. Described as a Jan Bhagidaari Abhiyaan, it encourages active participation from private hospitals and healthcare professionals to foster inclusive healthcare delivery.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi is scheduled to visit Arunachal Pradesh on Monday and lay the foundation for several key infrastructural projects in the state. During his daylong trip, PM Modi will virtually lay the foundation for the 2000 km Frontier highway project from IG Park, Itanagar. The Prime Minister will also lay the foundation of the Tato hydroelectric project in Shi-Yomi district. He will also launch the second phase of the Vibrant Village Programme.

Governor Lt. General KT Parnaik (Retd.) today participated in the virtual launching programme of Swasth Nari Sashakt Parivar Abhiyaan at Dorjee Khandu State Convention Center, Itanagar. The fortnight programme was launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi from Indore, Madhya Pradesh. Later in the day, the Governor accompanied by Chief Minister Pema Khandu launched the State's version Swasth Nari Sashakt Parivar Abhiyaan. They also visited the Health Kiosks and interacted with health officials and participants. The Governor advised them to ensure accessible and well-organized health services across the State to realize the shared goal of a Swasth Arunachal, Swachh Bharat. Chief Secretary Manish Gupta, State Health Minister Biyuram Wahge, Home Minister Mama Natung, Urban Development Minister Balo Raja, were present amongst others.

Chief Minister Pema Khandu today rolled out the Swachhata Hi Seva 2025 at IG Park, Itanagar with a Swachhata Pledge, dedicated to the vision of a cleaner environment. In a social media post, Khandu emphasised that 'Swachhata Hi Seva 2025' is not just about clean streets, it's about healthier families, a greener environment, and a

future we can all be proud of. He further added that, every effort counts and every hand joined makes Arunachal stronger, cleaner, and brighter. Home Minister, Mama Natung, Minister for Urban Affairs, Balo Raja, Advisor to Urban Affairs Minister Techhi Kaso, IMC Mayor, Tamme Phassang and other dignitaries were also present on the occasion.

The Swachhata Hi Seva 2025 campaign took place today in Dibang Valley district, igniting a collective spirit of cleanliness among its residents. Spearheaded by the District Administration in partnership with the Department of Urban Development & Housing and PHED Anini, this initiative promises to inspire positive change in the community. Around 150 enthusiastic participants including students, community members, and officials from various departments participated in the walkathon, "Walk for Swachh Anini".

Zilla Parishad Chairperson, Upper Siang, Lumgeng Litin today officially launched the Swasth Nari, Sashakt Parivar Abhiyaan along with the 8th Rashtriya Poshan Maah Campaign at the District Hospital, Yingkiong. On the occasion, the Chairperson inaugurated the Mega Blood Donation Drive (Raktdan Amrit Mahotsava) - a voluntary blood donation camp.

The National Award-winning film "Chalo Jeete Hain" a moving cinematic tribute to Swami Vivekananda's philosophy "Bas wahi jeete hain, jo doosro ke liye jeete hain" has been re-released across India and it will continue to be screened till October 2, 2025. The critically acclaimed film, among the most viewed short films of 2018, will be screened in lakhs of schools and nearly 500 cinema halls nationwide.

The Meteorological Centre of Itanagar has issued an orange alert for East Siang, Lower Dibang Valley and Dibang Valley district of Arunachal Pradesh, and has predicted thunderstorm with lightning and heavy rainfall is very likely at isolated places. Additionally, a yellow alert has also been issued for 15 districts.

India's star javelin thrower and defending champion Neeraj Chopra has qualified for World Athletics Championships 2025 Men's final today with his first attempt of 84.85 meters. Neeraj is aiming to become the third male javelin thrower in history to defend the World Championships gold title which he had clinched in the 2023 edition in Budapest. The qualification mark was 84.50 meters.
