The awards were given in various categories to celebrate excellence in filmmaking, storytelling, and acting. On the occasion, legendary actor, director, and producer, Mohanlal has been honoured with Dadasaheb Phalke Award, the highest recognition in the field of Cinema. The Best Feature Film Award was given to the Hindi movie '12th Fail,' while the Best Hindi Feature Film Award was presented to 'Kathal: A Jackfruit Mystery. In the Best Actor category, actor Shah Rukh Khan was honoured for his film Jawan while actor Vikrant Massey was confered for 12th Fail. The Best Actress award was given to actress Rani Mukerji for her performance in the film Mrs. Chatterjee vs. Norway.
