Chief Minister Pema Khandu today inaugurated the 3-day Craft Connect Arunachal-2025 (Handloom and Handicraft Expo) along with the newly built Smart City Artisan-Cum-Exhibition Centre at VKV Chimpu, Itanagar. In a social media post, Khandu said that the vibrant space with open trade fairgrounds, indoor games arena, prefabricated halls, and dedicated zones for artisans and S.H.Gs. will give a major boost to the States's Vocal for Local spirit. In the meantime, he invited everyone to visit and encourage the state's local artisans, as they display unique and authentic products that reflect the spirit of Arunachal. The initiative is spearheaded by Itanagar Smart City Development Corporation Ltd. in collaboration with key Government Departments, aiming to showcase and promote the rich handloom and handicraft traditions of Arunachal Pradesh.

Minister for Education, P.D. Sona today announced that the Arunachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission has recommended the progressive closure of North East Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital at Vivek Vihar, Itanagar; to safeguard student interests and protect academic standards. Sharing the news in a social media post, Sona informed that the decision was taken after thorough inspections and repeated observations of statutory non-compliance.
