NDA nominee and Maharashtra Governor CP Radhakrishnan have been elected as the 15th Vice President of India. He secured a total of 452 votes. Radhakrishnan, the ruling alliance's candidate, contested against INDIA bloc nominee Justice B. Sudershan Reddy, a former Supreme Court judge. Voting took place earlier in the day in Parliament, where Members of Parliament exercised their franchise between 10 am and 5 pm. The Vice-Presidential election was necessitated after Jagdeep Dhankhar resigned from the post on July 21 citing health reasons.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has announced a financial assistance of 1600 crore rupees for the flood affected Punjab in addition to 12,000 crore rupees already granted. There will be advance release of the second instalment of SDRF and PM Kisan Samman Nidhi. He also announced an ex-gratia of 2 lakh rupees to the next of kin of the deceased and 50,000 rupees to the seriously injured in the floods and natural calamity. He said the children orphaned due to these floods will be extended comprehensive support under the PM CARES for Children scheme. Earlier, after reaching Gurdaspur in Punjab to take stock of the ground situation of the flood ravaged state, PM Modi held a review meeting with senior officials on the extent of damage.

On this special day, I join my Khowa brethren in offering prayers to the Almighty for good health, peace, and contentment in everyone's lives, the Governor said in his message.

The theme for Swachhata Hi Seva 2025, "Swachhotsav", aims to promote cleanliness and sanitation through collective efforts. Speaking in the meeting, Minister Urban Affairs, Balo Raja emphasized the importance of community participation in achieving the objectives of Swachhata Hi Seva 2025. He urged all stakeholders to come forward and contribute to the initiative's success and take part in the nationwide shramdaan, 'Ek Din, Ek Ghanta, Ek Saath' on the 25th of September.

The Department of Disaster Management, Government of Arunachal Pradesh, in collaboration with the National Disaster Management Authority, Government of India, organized orientation-cum-coordination meeting today with all stakeholders to prepare for the upcoming Statewide Mock Exercise. The Meteorological Centre Itanagar has issued Yellow Alert for twelve districts of Arunachal Pradesh. MCI has predicted thunderstorm with lightning and heavy rain is very likely at isolated places.
