Guided by the mantra of Seva and Sushasan, that is, Public Service and Good Governance, the Government, under Prime Minister Narendra Modi, has positioned India as a global leader through the International Solar Alliance. The International Solar Alliance or ISA was launched at COP21 in Paris in November 2015 with 120 member and signatory countries, the ISA aims to mobilise over one thousand billion dollars in solar investments by 2030. Inaugurating the first assembly of the International Solar Alliance in New Delhi, Mr Modi had said that International Solar Alliance has emerged as a big ray of hope for the world.

State Health and Family Welfare Minister Biyuram Wahge called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt. General (Retd.) KT Parnaik at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar today. The Governor was briefed about health-related issues of the State and the launch of 'Swasth Nari, Sashakt Parivar Abhiyaan' and 8th Poshan Maah by the Prime Minister Modi. Governor Parnaik highlighting the well-being of women stressed that the intensified nationwide campaign on women's health should be implemented in mission mode, with collective commitment and urgency. He also advised the Minister to ensure that the health sector is adequately supported with skilled manpower and the effective use of modern technologies. Health Minister Wahge was accompanied by Advisor Dr Mohesh Chai.

4 days State Process Lab training programme under the Adi Karmayogi Abhiyan, by Social Justice, Empowerment & Tribal Affairs was launched today in Itanagar, State Banquet hall, with the aim of strengthening grassroots leadership and improving service delivery in the tribal areas in the state. Tirap, Longding, Namsai, East Siang and Kradadi district have been selected in the first phase of development projects. Arvin Kumar, Director, Ministry of tribal affairs, GoI also interacted with the participants through Video Conference. The Aadi Karmayogi Abhiyan is a flagship initiative of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India. Its objective is to create a cadre of about two million change leaders—drawn from tribal communities and allied stakeholders.

'Arogya Dhaam' – A Health and Fitness Hub at Yupia Mini Secretariat was inaugurated today by Minister for RD & Panchayati Raj, Ojing Tasing. Lauding the initiative, Minister Ojing Tasing urged all officials and staff to make the best use of the facility. Conceived as the brainchild of Deputy Commissioner, Papum Pare, Ms. Vishakha Yadav, the facility aims to provide a dedicated space for officers and staff of the Secretariat to engage in physical exercise, meditation, and yoga during their free time.

The District Road Safety Committee, Papum Pare, today launched the weeklong Road Safety Awareness Week with a grand bike rally. Deputy Commissioner, Vishakha Yadav flagged off the rally, from Dree Ground Junction which culminated at the Golden Jubilee Outdoor Stadium, Yupia. Attending the occasion, Chief Secretary, Manish Gupta, stressed on good driving practices and called for proactive steps to address the problem of stray animals, which often cause road accidents. Transport Minister Ojing was also present. During this Safety Awareness painting and slogan-writing competitions, free helmet distribution, vehicle check-ups, and multiple outreach initiatives will be undertaken.

In Yachuli, in preparation for the State-Level Mock Exercise on earthquake, landslide, and Glacial Lake Outburst Flood scenarios, scheduled for September 18, a coordination meeting was held yesterday, chaired by Likha Tejji, ADC Yachuli, with all Heads of Departments, Heads of Offices, and stakeholders of Keyi Panyor district. The Mock Exercise will be conducted simultaneously across all districts of Arunachal Pradesh on 18th September. Five sites in Keyi Panyor — Govt. Secondary School, Mini Secretariat, Panyor Dam, PHC Yachuli, and Yachuli Market — have been identified for simulation of earthquake damage.

Kurung Kumey Deputy Commissioner, Cheechung Chukhu today convened the District Level Monitoring Committee with Heads of Offices and senior officials from various departments. The committee deliberated on several key areas, including strict adherence to government policies and guidelines, effective utilization of allocated funds, and the importance of capacity building among field staff and community volunteers. Deputy Commissioner directed all departments to submit progress reports at regular intervals and scheduled the next review meeting within the coming quarter.

In Daporijo, the week long Summer Badminton Championship tournament under theme "NO TO DRUGS" YES TO BADMINTON organised by Khelo India Centre Athletes concluded yesterday at Khelo India Centre in Government Higher Secondary School. Upper Subansiri Deputy Commisioner Tasso Gambo, Chief Guest of the closing ceremony informed at present there are five Badminton courts in District Headquarter including Khelo India Khelo infrastructure of Lida Village near Daporijo Head quarter. He urged to all the denizens to avail the sport facility and keep the District Drug free by adopting the sportsman spirit and attitude.

The Meteorological Centre of Itanagar has issued Yellow Alert for twenty-two districts of Arunachal Pradesh, and predicted thunderstorm with lightning and heavy rain is very likely at isolated places.
