Union Minister of Development of North Eastern Region Jyotiraditya Scindia has said that the Northeast has become the growth engine of the country. Addressing the media on the one-year achievement of his Ministry in New Delhi today, Mr. Scindia said that over the past 11 years, the government has worked to showcase the North East region's potential on the global stage. He said the number of Airports in the North East has increased to 17 from just 9 airports in the last eleven years. Mr Scindia also highlighted that the National Highways in the North East states have increased from ten thousand kilometres to 16 thousand kilometres. The Minister highlighted that several initiatives were taken to unlock the investment and growth potential of the North East region. Mr Scindia said that four lakh 48 thousand crore rupees investment commitment was secured during the Rising North East summit held in May this year.

Defence minister Rajnath Singh today unveiled the first Tejas LCA MK1A fighter jet from Hindustan Aeronautics' new Nashik production line. During the event, the defence minister also inaugurated a second production line for the HTT-40 trainer aircraft at the same facility. Speaking on the occasion, Mr. Singh said, the maiden flight of the Tejas LCA Mk1A fighter jet marks a significant milestone in country's journey toward self-reliance in defence manufacturing. He praised the Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd. facility in Nashik, highlighting its crucial role as a strong pillar in bolstering the country's defence manufacturing capabilities over the past six decades. The Minister reaffirmed the government's commitment to achieving self-reliance in defence production, stating it is the country's resolve to manufacture all defence equipment within the country.
