Prime Minister Narendra Modi has said that digital connectivity in the country is no longer a privilege or luxury but an integral part of every citizen's life. Mr Modi was speaking after inaugurating the ninth edition of the India Mobile Congress, Asia's largest telecom, media, and technology event at Yashobhoomi in New Delhi today. He said, the country is emerging as an effective platform for innovation and progress.

The four-day event will showcase the latest advancements in telecom and emerging technologies, bringing together global leaders, policymakers, industry experts, and innovators.

The Government of Nagaland has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Capacity Building Commission, Karmayogi Bharat to implement Mission Karmayogi. This was signed during a day-long workshop on the Mission held at the Capital Convention Hall in Kohima today. Nagaland Chief Secretary Sentiyanger Imchen emphasized that Mission Karmayogi, launched in 2020 by the Central Government, aims to create a future-ready civil service focused on effective governance and service delivery. Highlighting the importance of continuous training, he said officers can now access learning through the digital platform iGOT Karmayogi. The online mode will make training more inclusive and accessible, especially in remote areas, Mr Imchen said, calling on all departments to prioritize and institutionalize regular capacity building. He noted that the Administrative Training Institute (ATI) and the Department of Personal and Administrative Reforms will be the implementing and monitoring agencies in the state. Director ATI, Akunu S. Meyase, underlined ongoing efforts to strengthen training infrastructure in Nagaland, including a new web portal to track training histories and needs of government employees. The workshop was attended by Administrative Heads, Heads of Department and senior officials.

An iron water treatment plant and a children's and adolescent's library were inaugurated today at Officers' Hill Colony in Kohima. Inaugurating the water

treatment plant at a programme in Government Middle School, KMC Ward 10 Councillor Kevinei-ü Sekhose highlighted the colony's struggle with high iron content in bore water, and ackowledged the support of community leaders and others in completing the project.
