The GST Bachat Utsav kicked off on 22nd September as the Narendra Modi government slashed GST rates in many sectors, benefitting citizens across the country. Today, our correspondent brings a report on how the new GST rates in the Apparel footwear sector are helping citizens. A report:

[**VC**- **sec** The next-generation GST reforms have provided major relief to the apparel and footwear sector. Under the new tax structure, GST has been reduced to 5 percent for upto 2,500 rupees per piece on Readymade Garments. This rationalisation has stimulated domestic demand in small towns and rural regions. Similarly, the tax rates on man-made yarns has been reduced from 12 percent to 5 percent, reducing reliance on imports and boosting exports. In addition, footwear priced up to 2 thousand and five hundred rupees per pair now attract only 5 percent GST instead of 12 percent, making stylish and durable footwear more accessible to young and middle-income consumers].



And, The first state-level sub-junior, junior, and senior Wushu (Sanda) Championship, organized by Nagaland Wushu Association (NWA) in collaboration with the Department of Youth Resources and Sports, culminated yesterday at the Pele Khezhie Indoor Stadium, Kohima.
