Prime Minister Narendra Modi in Mann ki Baat today has said that the inauguration of the world's largest leap engine MRO facility in Hyderabad, the induction of INS Mahé into the Indian Navy, unveiling of Skyroot's Infinity Campus in the country, reflect India's new thinking, innovation and youth power. Further he said, India has set a historic record with food grain production of 357 million tonnes. He further noted, November 2025 has been a super hit in terms of sports in India while mentioning all the wins in Cricket, Kabaddi and Boxing. Mr Modi again urged people to carry forward the mantra of 'vocal for local'. He said, a few days ago, during the G-20 Summit he has reiterated the sentiment 'Vocal for Local'. Mr Modi said, he was deeply impressed by the efforts being made in South India towards natural farming. The Prime Minister said, India is setting new records in honey production as it has now almost doubled during the last 11 years.

The Government today held an all-Party Meeting at the Parliament House Annexe ahead of the Winter Session of Parliament beginning tomorrow till 19th December. Union Defence Minister Rajnath Singh chaired the meeting. Speaking after the meeting, Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kiren Rijiju said, the meeting was held in a positive atmosphere. He said, the Government has appealed to the floor leaders of all political parties for cooperation during the Winter Session for smooth functioning of the two Houses.

The General Officer Commanding-in-Chief, Eastern Command, Lt. General RC Tiwari accompanied by General Officer Commanding, 3 Corps, Lt. General Abhijit S Pendharkar, called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt. General KT Parnaik at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar, yesterday. They discussed a wide range of issues, including the security of the eastern borders, the welfare of ex-servicemen, and the land issue cases, along with other matters concerning the Army's engagement with the State Government.

In Lower Subansiri District, Ziro, a coordination meeting was conducted yesterday ahead of the Panchayat Election chaired by Election Observer Pagli Sora. During the meeting, DEO Oli Perme expressed happiness that a majority of the ZPM seats are uncontested this time-10

out of 14 ZPCs, reflecting a positive and cooperative democratic environment. Election Observer Sora, representing the State Election Commission, emphasised that the Observer functions as the “eyes and ears” of the Commission. He encouraged everyone to reach out anytime for matters related to free and fair elections.

Tawang Deputy Commissioner cum DEO Panchayati Raj, Namgyal Angmo, yesterday officially handed over the Election Certificates to all the uncontested Gram Panchayat members of the 3-Tawang and 4-Kitpi Zila Parishad Constituencies, following the closure of the withdrawal period.

The NCORD meeting for the month of October 2025 was conducted on yesterday at, Likabali, Lower Siang. The meeting was chaired by Mokar Riba, ADC, Likabali, who urged all stakeholders to strengthen collaboration, intensify outreach and awareness programmes, and ensure sustained support for rehabilitation and preventive initiatives.

Rajiv Gandhi University, Rono Hills, Doimukh, held its 23<sup>rd</sup> Convocation today. Arunachal Pradesh Governor KT Parnaik presided over the convocation. Degrees were conferred upon 115 PhD scholars, 911 postgraduates, and 6,331 undergraduates, along with 127 recipients of postgraduate diplomas for the academic session 2024-25. 46 gold medal winners from postgraduate programmes and 31 gold medal winners from undergraduate programmes were honoured for their outstanding achievements. The Pushpa Rani Mitra Gold Medal was also conferred. Prof S. Mahendra Dev, Chairman of the Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister of India, delivered the convocation address.

The Indian Army organised an open volleyball tournament for boys and girls in Menchuka, under the theme “Spikes, Serves & Camaraderie” from 26–29 November 2025. The initiative reflects the Army’s commitment to supporting remote communities, nurturing young sporting talent, and enhancing the well-being of students in far-flung regions. A total of 14 teams participated, including four school boys’ teams, four club boys’ teams, and six girls’ teams. Arunachal Pradesh Minister of Parliamentary Affairs P. D. Sona, graced the event and interacted with the participants.

The 4th District Level Arm Wrestling Championship 2025 was organised yesterday at Kiyit Indoor Stadium Mebo Circle, East Siang District, by the East Siang District Arm Wrestling Association Under the Aegis of District Olympic Association and All Arunachal Pradesh Arm Wrestling Association. Chief Guest of the occasion, Local MLA Oken Tayeng in a social media post commended the organisers for promoting sports and creating this platform for the district's youth.

Social Justice and Empowerment Minister Virendra Kumar today addressing the 53rd Foundation Day of Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation of India – ALIMCO in New Delhi, highlighted that over the past eleven years, more than 32 lakh Divyang beneficiaries have been supported with modern assistive devices.
