Prime Minister Narendra Modi addressed the first session of the G20 Summit in Johannesburg, South Africa today, which focused on inclusive and sustainable growth. With Africa hosting the G20 Summit for the first time, Mr. Modi said that this is the right moment to revisit global development parameters and prioritise growth that is both inclusive and sustainable. He added that India's civilisational values, particularly the principle of Integral Humanism, offer a meaningful way forward. Also, PM Modi proposed for the creation of a G20 Global Healthcare Response Team, emphasising that the world is stronger when it works together during health emergencies and natural disasters. Further, he stated that efforts should be to create teams of trained medical experts from fellow G20 nations who are ready for rapid deployment in case of any emergencies. PM Modi also proposed a G20 Initiative on Countering the Drug-Terror Nexus.

Union Home Minister Amit Shah has congratulated the workers of the country on the nationwide implementation of the new Labour Codes. In a social media post, the Minister said that these codes, crafted under the leadership of PM Modi, represent the biggest reform in the history of labour laws. Mr Shah said that these codes guarantee minimum wages to workers, social security, equal opportunities for women workers, and legal recognition for gig and unorganised workers.

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has stressed that today's new world requires a new United Nations and international order to tackle global conflicts. The Minister was speaking at the 'International Conference of Chief Justices of the World' in Lucknow yesterday. He said, the UN could have played a much stronger role in global conflicts such as Israel-Hamas and Ukraine-Russia, and in humanitarian crises unfolding in Sudan. The Minister said, a balance representation in the United Nations is the need of the hour to keep this international body alive. He said, the situation can change only when we bring the United Nations back to its core objectives, peace, justice, and equal representation as originally envisioned.

Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt General (Retd) KT Parnaik reviewed the implementation and utilization of PM GatiShakti in the State at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar today. State Chief Secretary Manish Gupta, Commissioner (Planning) Ankur Garg and other officials made a presentation on its applications. The Governor emphasized that every department of the State must make full and effective use of the PM GatiShakti repository while planning and executing developmental projects.
