Dr. Tai Nyori, Former Registrar and Controller of Examinations at Rajiv Gandhi University passed away last night. He was the first NEFA candidate to qualify the B.A and M.A. History Honours and enter teaching profession as lecturer. He was also the first Arunachalee to qualify the Ph.D. in History subject in 1988. He joined Rajiv Gandhi University in 1990, first as Controller of Examinations, and as Registrar. For his pioneering services in the field of education and academic administration, he was awarded the Glory of India Gold Medal and Vijay Rattan Award by New Delhi based social organizations and from the Department of Higher education, Government of Arunachal Pradesh. Besides, Dr. Nyori was the

founder President of the Indigenous Faith and Cultural Society of Arunachal Pradesh (IFCSAP) when it was formed in 1999. His research work on History and Culture of the Adis has been well received by the scholars of the country and abroad. He has published and presented more than 50 research papers in several journals and seminars and conferences.
