Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman today carried out a series of engagements on the second day of her visit to Nagaland, aimed at empowering local communities and boosting development. In Kiphire, Ms Sitharaman inaugurated the new Industrial Training Institute, and handed over 9 lakh rupees as part of SBI's CSR initiative to enhance skill development. Later, at a Credit Outreach Programme, she virtually inaugurated nine bank branches across the Northeast, and handed over sanction letters to beneficiaries of various Central Government Schemes. At the event, loans totaling 28.02 crore rupees were disbursed to 350 beneficiaries. Addressing the event, the Union Minister highlighted the government's ongoing efforts to develop the Northeast, stressing its importance in India's growth trajectory.

Underscoring the progress of financial inclusion programs, Ms Sitharaman pointed to the reduction of unbanked villages in Nagaland from 1,143 in 2019 to just 15 today. She highlighted the growing economic empowerment in the region, particularly among women, through welfare and financial schemes. She also commended the region's rich cultural heritage and preservation of traditions.

Earlier, the Minister flagged off vehicles sanctioned under Chief Minister's Micro Finance Initiative, along with a mobile ATM van of Nagaland Rural Bank. She also visited the Anganwadi Centre in Kiphire and contributed 2 lakh rupees for its upgradation. Meanwhile, Ms Sitharaman also interacted with Lakhpati Didis and encouraged them to inspire other women across the country. Meanwhile, in Kohima, the Finance Minister launched SAMARTH

(Students Advancing Mindsets in AI, Robotics Technology and Digital Hardware) portal at NIELIT this evening.



The counting of votes is underway for all 243 assembly seats in Bihar amid tight security. Trends available so far indicate that the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) is heading towards a landslide victory in the state assembly polls. The NDA has won 109 seats and leading in 93. RJD-led Mahagathbandhan is trailing far behind, having won 15 seats and leading in 20. Others have won five seats and leading in one. Among the winners are BJP candidate and Deputy Chief Minister Samrat Choudhary. Mahagathbandhan's Chief Ministerial candidate Tejashwi Prasad Yadav of RJD, who was initially trailing, made a turn around and has been declared elected from Raghopur seat.



Nagaland Chief Minister Neiphiu Rio has congratulated the NDA on securing the mandate of the people in the Bihar Elections. In a social media post, Mr Rio said, the outcome reflects the democratic will of the electorate and their confidence in the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Chief Minister of Bihar Nitish Kumar.



Nagaland's Icaisuile has been recognized for her exceptional contribution to the fisheries sector at the World Fisheries India 2025 held in Hyderabad recently. Four individuals have been arrested in Wokha, in connection with the alleged sexual assault of a 15-year-old girl. Superintendent of Police Wokha, T. Relo Aye said, the arrests follow a written complaint received on November 10, regarding the incident that occurred on November 4. The accused have been identified Chumlanthung Y Humtsoe, Zurenthung R Odyuo, Zuchanbemo Felix, and Khyothungo Yanthan. The case has been registered under the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act. During the investigation, another individual, Myinthungo Humtsoe, was

identified as an accomplice but is currently absconding. The victim is under the care of the Child Welfare Committee, and police investigation is ongoing.



Vice President C.P. Radhakrishnan has said India is rapidly emerging as a prosperous nation. The 113 Infantry Battalion (TA) Rajput, Dimapur, will hold a Territorial Army recruitment rally tomorrow for the positions of Soldier (General Duty), Clerk, and Tradesmen.
