Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone of a fertiliser plant worth 10 thousand 601 crore rupees at Namrup in Dibrugarh district of Assam today. The project is aimed at strengthening fertiliser production and supporting agricultural growth in the region. Earlier today, Prime Minister visited the Swahid Smarak Kshetra at Paschim Boragaon in Guwahati, where he paid homage to the martyrs of the Assam Movement. Yesterday, Mr Modi inaugurated the New Terminal Building of Lokapriya Gopinath Bardoloi International Airport in Guwahati. Prime Minister also unveiled a statue of Bharat Ratna Lokapriya Gopinath Bardoloi at the entrance of the new terminal complex.

Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein, along with former Chief Minister Mukut Mithi, after experiencing river rafting on the mighty Dibang River at Dambuk, lauded KABOS Adventure for promoting world-class adventure sports in Arunachal Pradesh. President Droupadi Murmu has given assent to the Viksit Bharat—Guarantee for Rozgar and Aajeevika Mission (Gramin) (VB—G RAM G) Bill, 2025. The Act enhances the statutory wage employment guarantee to 125 days per financial year for rural households and seeks to advance empowerment, inclusive growth, convergence of development initiatives and saturation-based delivery, thereby strengthening the foundation for a prosperous, resilient and self-reliant Rural Bharat. The Act replaces the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), 2005 with a modern statutory framework that enhances livelihood security and is aligned with the national vision of Viksit Bharat @2047.

The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology has issued an advisory saying that a cyber campaign, called GhostPairing, is being used for hijacking WhatsApp accounts. The Ministry said that the offenders or hijackers are exploiting WhatsApp's device-linking feature to hijack accounts using pairing codes without authentication requirement.
