National Farmers' Day is being observed across the nation today. The day honours the contributions of farmers to the nation's growth and development. This day marks the birth anniversary of former Prime Minister Chaudhary Charan Singh, renowned for his deep understanding of rural issues and unwavering advocacy for farmers' welfare.

Chief Minister Pema Khandu has announced the launch of an Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning skilling programme in Arunachal Pradesh following an MoU with Ranchovation Labs Pvt. Ltd., supported by IIT Delhi. The initiative will offer a 60-hour job-ready AI course for college students, graduates and youth, along with a five-day AI Explorer Bootcamp for school students from Classes 6 to 12. The programme is scheduled to begin from 12 January 2026. N

IGP, Law and Order, Chukhu Apa, updated on the ongoing investigation into the arrest of individuals involved in spying activities. On credible information, Arunachal Pradesh Police Itanagar led by Jummar Basar, SP Itanagar on 21 November 2025 arrested Nazir Ahmad Malik of Kupwara, Kashmir. Interrogation led to two more arrests from the same location. Investigation revealed the suspects were sharing sensitive information with handlers across the border. IGP Apa warned that allowing outsiders to stay in Arunachal without police verification is a serious issue and urged people to verify tenants to ensure the safety of themselves and society.

Som Kamei, Planning Adviser, North Eastern Council, yesterday called on Arunachal Pradesh Chief Minister Pema Khandu, to discuss development priorities and planning perspectives for the Northeastern region. Mr Kamei also met State's Education and Rural Development Minister, P. D. Sona, at his residence to deliberate on key initiatives.

Vishnu Narlikar has been honoured with Vigyan Ratna award posthumously. Eight scientists were conferred with Vigyan Shree award and 14 young scientists were awarded under the Vigyan Yuva category while the Vigyan Team award was given to Team Aroma Mission CSIR.

In a commercial mission, ISRO is scheduled to launch the new generation US communication satellite Bluebird Block-2 spacecraft tomorrow at 8:54 am local time. The satellite is part of AST SpaceMobile's next-generation system to provide direct cellular broadband connectivity to standard smartphones without special hardware. It aims to offer global 4G/5G connectivity, enabling calls, web access, and video services directly from space. BlueBird Block-2 will be the largest commercial communication satellite in LEO and the heaviest payload launched by LVM3 from India.
