ELEMENT Nagaland Project today signed Memoranda of Agreement with the Department of Land Resources and the Nagaland Empowerment of People through Economic Development (NEPED) for implementation of the project. The agreement with the Land Resources Department focuses on strengthening spring rejuvenation and coffee development in the state. Meanwhile, NEPED's Centre of Excellence for Renewable Energy Studies will serve as a state technical partner for research, innovation and technology development. Addressing the programme, Additional Chief Secretary & ELEMENT Mission Director, V. Shashank Shekhar, said similar collaborations will be extended to other departments.

The ELEMENT Project aims to restore degraded landscapes, build climate resilience, and improve livelihoods across Nagaland. With a total cost of 574.63 crore rupees, the project will cover 225 villages in 16 districts, over a five-year period ending in 2030.

Nagaland's Health & Family Welfare Department has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with HLL Lifecare Limited, a Public Sector Undertaking under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, to start AMRIT (Affordable Medicine and Reliable Implants for Treatment) Pharmacies in the state. AMRIT Pharmacy aims to provide essential medicines and surgical disposables at significant discounts, particularly for life-threatening diseases like cancer and heart ailments. Under the MoU, HLL Lifecare will set up a warehouse at the State Family Welfare Training Institute in Chumoukedima, to supply to public hospitals. It will also open AMRIT Pharmacy outlets at key public hospitals to ensure citizens have access to affordable quality medical supplies. The MoU was signed by Principal Director Dr. Mereninla Senlem and Senior Manager (RBD-North East) of HLL Lifecare, Dilip Kumar Mishra.

The Lok Sabha has passed the Viksit Bharat - Guarantee for Rozgar and Ajeevika Mission (Gramin) 2025 Bill, amid opposition uproar over its provisions. The legislation will replace the 20-year-old Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005. The Bill seeks to establish a rural development framework aligned with the national vision of Viksit Bharat @2047. Under the legislation, a statutory guarantee of 125 days of wage employment will be provided in every financial year to every rural household whose adult members volunteer to undertake unskilled manual work. Replying to the discussion on the Bill, Union Rural Development Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan said, under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the MGNREGA scheme has been implemented in a proper and effective manner.

The fund-sharing pattern between the central government and state governments will be 60:40 for all states other than the North-eastern and the Himalayan states, wherein the sharing arrangement will be 90:10. State governments will continue to pay unemployment allowance and compensation. The bill provides for using biometric authentication for transactions, geospatial technology for planning and monitoring, mobile application-based dashboards for real-time tracking, and weekly public disclosure systems. All works undertaken under this Bill will be aggregated into the Viksit Bharat National Rural Infrastructure Stack,

creating a unified national framework for rural public works.



Prime Minister Narendra Modi has been conferred with the 'Order of Oman', the Sultanate's uniquely distinct civilian honour, by Sultan Haitham bin Tarik for his contributions to India-Oman ties and his visionary leadership. The conferment was made during a ceremony at the Royal Palace in Muscat, today. Prime Minister Modi has dedicated the honour to the age-old friendship between both the countries and called it a tribute to the warmth and affection between the 1.4 billion people of India and the people of Oman. Earlier, India and Oman signed the Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement, marking a historic milestone in bilateral relations. The agreement was signed by Union Minister of Commerce and Industry, Piyush Goyal and his Oman counterpart, Qais Al Yousef in the presence of the Sultan of Oman and Minister Modi. The agreement unlocks unprecedented opportunities for India's labour-intensive sectors and will create more jobs, better market access and greater economic opportunities for both the countries. The two sides also signed MoUs in the fields of maritime heritage, education, agriculture, and millet cultivation.



Prime Minister Narendra Modi has said, diversity in India is a strong base of its culture and for Indians every day brings in new colours, every season becomes a new festival, every tradition comes with a new idea. He was addressing the Indian community and students in Muscat in a programme called Maitri Parv on the second day his visit to Oman today. He said, Indian diaspora has become a living example of co-existence and co-operation.

The programme 'Maitri Parv' celebrates the completion of 50 years of the Indian schooling system in Oman. Earlier this morning, the Prime Minister addressed the India-Oman Business Summit attended by business leaders from both the countries. Prime Minister Narendra Modi has since left for Delhi after concluding his successful three-nation visit to Oman, Ethiopia and Jordan.
