Deputy Commissioner Kohima, B. Henok Buchem, along with SDO Civil Sechü-Zubza Imliakum, Nodal Officer Thejangulie Zao, District Commandant HG, CD & SDRF Wopenthung and other district officials from Police, Forest & Fire Emergency Services today visited the base camp of the team engaged in combating the Western Dzükou fire at Khonoma. During the visit, Khonoma Youth representatives, SDRF, and other government agencies briefed the officials on the current situation. They informed that an inspection team had been sent and

reported the presence of smoke in between burnt bushes, but no active flames were observed. IAF Helicopters were also deployed, operating with Bambi buckets to suppress and contain the smoke. It was further mentioned that western Dzükou has been closed temporarily as a precautionary measure. We have a report:

A discussion was also held on whether to continue the operation. While the helicopter team from Kharagpur, along with youth volunteers and SDRF personnel, expressed confidence that the fire had been contained, it was decided that a team would trek again to Western Dzükou tomorrow to further assure the situation on the ground. Deputy Commissioner Buchem expressed gratitude to God and to all those involved, and particularly applauded the spirit of human compassion shown by the team, especially the people of Khonoma. Earlier in the day, Advisor NSDMA & NRE, Z. Nyusietho Nyuthe along with district administration and NSDMA official conducted an aerial survey of both the Western and Southern Dzükou areas using a helicopter to assess the overall fire situation.

The workshop focused on strengthening awareness, enforcement of tobacco control laws, and promoting tobacco-free institutions. During the programme the ADC Office Pughoboto was declared as Tobacco-Free Office while it also recognized five Tobacco-Free Schools for compliance with Tobacco-Free Educational Institutions guidelines.

Deputy Director and State Nodal Officer, NTCP, Dr. I. Simon Sumi, highlighted the tobacco burden in Nagaland and stressed the importance of district and subdivision level stakeholders in effective NTCP implementation.



The 3rd Capacity Building Training of Trainers for vocational trainers under the NEP Multi Sector Skill Education initiative was held today in Dimapur. It was organised by Lend A Hand India (LAHI) in collaboration with Samagra Shiksha, Department of School Education, Nagaland. The one-day training brought together vocational trainers from 26 government schools participating in the NEP Multi Sector Skill Education pilot aligned with NEP 2020 and NCF 2023.

The sessions were facilitated by Ayushi Sharma, Manager (Training), and Metseruyi Tetseo, Senior Instructor, LAHI. Building on earlier ToTs, the workshop focused on strengthening classroom pedagogy, adolescent understanding, supportive learning environments, and translating policy into effective classroom practice. Trainers explored lesson planning, sequencing, learning outcomes, and assessment strategies across sectors such as Agriculture, Mechatronics, Finance, Fashion, Healthcare and Coding. Participants engaged in group work to design lesson plans and micro-teaching activities emphasising hands-on learning, higher-order thinking, and real-world exposure through quest lectures and field visits.



Union Aviation Minister Ram Mohan Naidu has said that the Tariff Monitoring Unit working under the DGCA will be further strengthened to closely monitor the

airfares. Replying to supplementaries during the Question Hour in the Rajya Sabha today, Mr Naidu said that in addition to domestic routes the airfares on International routes are now also being monitored. He said, whenever there is a possibility of a rise in airfares, the Ministry takes necessary action. The Minister said, in view of the recent Indigo crisis, leading to huge cancellation of regular flights, the Ministry stepped in and capped the airfares to keep it reasonable and affordable.

The Civil Aviation Minister said, a tariff monitoring facility has been provided on the Air Sewa portal and if any passenger feels that the airfare is excessively high then, they can send a screenshot to the Ministry through the portal.
