Union Home Minister Amit Shah yesterday launched projects worth one thousand 715 crore rupees, including the second legislative assembly complex, in Dibrugarh, Assam. Addressing a public meeting at Dibrugarh, Mr. Shah said, the India-European Union Free Trade Agreement will boost Assam tea exports to European countries.

Mr. Shah urged the electors to vote in favour of BJP in the next assembly polls for development, peace, security, industry, flood-free Assam. Accusing the previous Congress government for neglecting the Assam, Mr. Shah said, Congress used infiltration as weapon for its vote bank politics. He said that under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the government is bringing infrastructure projects for the development of the state.
