Prime Minister Narendra Modi today inaugurated the Emergency Landing Facility on Moran Bypass, developed along a national highway in Dibrugarh district of Assam. The Prime Minister also witnessed an aerial display of fighter jets, transport aircraft, and helicopters, including the Indian Air Force's Sukhoi Su-30MKI, Rafale, AN-32, Tejas, and Advanced Light Helicopters. The Emergency Landing Facility is the first of its kind in Northeast India, designed and constructed in coordination with the Indian Air Force. Prime Minister Narendra Modi also inaugurated the Kumar Bhaskar Varma Setu across River Brahmaputra connecting Guwahati and North Guwahati along with several other developmental projects worth over 5,450 crore rupees. Further, PM Modi virtually inaugurated the temporary campus of IIM Guwahati and the National Data Centre for North Eastern Region at Amingaon in Kamrup district. In addition, He also flagged off 225 electric buses under the PM-eBus Sewa Scheme for four cities of India. 100 buses for Guwahati, 50 each for Nagpur and Bhavnagar and 25 buses for Chandigarh.

Arunachal Pradesh Governor Lt General Retd. KT Parnaik, participated in the two-day seminar 'Arunachal Pradesh – India's Dynamic Frontier' held at Headquarters 2 Mountain Division, Dinjan in Assam. The Governor said that along the borders with Myanmar and Bhutan, culture and security intersect in complex ways. He highlighted the State's border challenges, developmental progress, and strategic potential, stressing that security and development are deeply linked. The Governor called for a Whole-of-Nation Approach to strengthen Arunachal's security, inclusive development, and economic growth. On the occasion, Former civil servant and Indian Ambassador Phunchok Stobdan examined Arunachal-Tibet linkages, culture, and their wider historical contours. Further, writer, military historian, and filmmaker Shiv Kunal Verma spoke on flora, fauna, eco-tourism, and the region's latent potential.

The construction work of the 132 kV Namsai Miao Transmission Line has resumed at Avoipur village with the active support of the District Administration of Changlang district. Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein shared the news in a social media post. He said the important infrastructure project will significantly strengthen power connectivity in the region and contribute to the overall development of our border areas. The

Deputy CM appreciated the cooperation of the local community and the committed efforts of the POWERGRID team in moving the project forward.

The second day of the 22nd National Mountain Bike Cycling Championships in Roing, Arunachal Pradesh, witnessed intense competition in various Cross-Country Time Trial categories. In the Sub Junior Girls Cross-Country Time Trial category, Hashini K from Tamil Nadu clinched the gold medal. In the Women Elite Cross-Country Time Trial event, Star Narzary from Karnataka secured the gold medal. The Women Junior Cross-Country Individual category saw Sowbarnika S from Tamil Nadu emerge as the gold medal winner. Pranesh S of Tamil Nadu bagged the gold medal in the Sub Junior Boys Cross-Country Time Trial category. In the Men Junior Cross-Country Time Trial category, Sonawane Yogesh from Maharashtra claimed the gold medal.

Women and Child Development minister Dasanglu Pul on Saturday reviewed the progress of the Vibrant Villages Programme (VVP) road from Goiliang to Glotonglat and inspected several ongoing education and administrative infrastructure projects in Anjaw district's Goiliang Circle.
