Prime Minister Narendra Modi has said that Seva Teerth and Kartavya Bhavan have been built to fulfil the aspirations of the people of the country. Speaking after the complexes were inaugurated, which will house his new office, he said these reflect government's commitment to citizen-centric governance and national progress.

In its very first set of decisions after shifting to Seva Teerth, the Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved PM RAHAT Scheme, Doubling of target of Lakhpati Didis to six crores, Agriculture Infrastructure Fund Doubled to two lakh crore rupees and Startup India Fund of Funds 2.0 with a corpus of 10 thousand crore rupees.

The first batch of trainees at Drone School – Drone Centre of Excellence under the Nagaland GIS & Remote Sensing Centre (NGISRSC), Planning and Transformation Department, Government of Nagaland completed 14-day FPV Drone Training Programme yesterday. Development Commissioner, Temsunaro Aier highlighted the importance of skill-based education and emerging technologies such as drone operations in governance, planning, disaster response and development. Describing drone technology as a key 21st-century skill, she encouraged trainees to upgrade their skills and explore opportunities in indigenous manufacturing in line with the vision of Atmanirbhar Bharat. The Development Commissioner announced the introduction of two specialised non-DGCA courses — Drone Cinematography and Drone GIS Mapping & Survey — tailored to state-specific needs. The second batch of ten trainees has begun training in Drone Repair & Maintenance.

Food Safety Administration, Kohima Zone Team will conduct online FSSAI Licensing and Registration Camps for Food Business Operators (FBOs) across four locations in Kohima town from 16th to 19th February. The camps will be held at High School Colony on 16th & 17th February; P.R. Hill Colony on 18th February and Lerie Colony on 19th February. Food Business Operators yet to obtain FSSAI License or Registration have been directed to attend the camps and carry self-attested passport size photograph and one identification proof such as Aadhaar, PAN, Voter ID, Driving License or Passport. Authorities informed that similar online licensing camps will also be conducted at Pfutsero, Chozuba and Wokha.
