Prime Minister Narendra Modi flagged off Meerut Metro and Namoo Bharat Train at Shatabdi Nagar Namoo Bharat Station in Meerut, Uttar Pradesh yesterday . Mr Modi also undertook Metro Ride till Meerut South Station and interacted with students and passengers. The Prime Minister dedicated to the Nation entire 82 Km Delhi-Meerut Namoo Bharat Corridor and inaugurated the remaining sections of India's first Namoo Bharat Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS).With a design speed of 180 km per hour, Namoo Bharat is India's first Regional Rapid Transit System connecting major urban centres such as Sahibabad, Ghaziabad, Modinagar and Meerut with Delhi at a faster pace. The Prime Minister also flagged off Meerut Metro services between Meerut South and Modipuram, operating on the same infrastructure as Namoo Bharat, in a first-of-its-kind initiative in the country. Meerut Metro is India's fastest metro system with maximum operational speed of around 120 kilometers per hour. It covers the entire stretch in just 30 minutes. Later, Prime Minister Modi also inaugurated and dedicated to the nation various development projects worth around 12,930 crore rupees in Meerut. Addressing the gathering, Prime Minister Modi said the projects launched will give thrust to Viksit Uttar Pradesh, and Viksit Bharat.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi yesterday cautioned citizens against rising incidents of digital fraud and so-called "digital arrest" scams, urging people to remain vigilant and follow proper banking procedures to safeguard their hard-earned savings. Speaking during the 131st episode of his monthly radio programme Mann Ki Baat, the Prime Minister said that although awareness about digital fraud had increased, troubling incidents were still being reported.

PM Modi also stressed that KYC or re-KYC should be done only through the bank branch, official app, and authorized medium. Prime Minister Modi asked people to pay heed to the Reserve Bank of India's message and keep their KYC updated.

The Government has warned the attendees of India AI Impact Summit 2026 against a Phishing Scam. In a social media post, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology said, fraudulent messages are being circulated via SMS and WhatsApp, requesting sensitive information to facilitate refunds. It said that these communications are not official and have not been authorized by the organization. The Ministry further urged all attendees to remain vigilant against unsolicited requests for card numbers or WhatsApp contact details.

In a major boost to soybean cultivation and farmer empowerment, Nagaland hosted its first-ever Soybean Festival at Agri Expo, Chümoukedima from February 20 to 21, bringing together over 200 farmers, scientists, and agricultural officials from across the state. Speaking at the event, Director of the Department of Agriculture, Government of Nagaland, Sanuzo Nienu highlighted soybean as a "miracle"

or “golden” bean for its high protein content, soil-enriching properties, and strong market potential. During the two day festival, experts from the Nagaland University and ICAR–National Bureau of Plant Genetic Resources, New Delhi emphasized on improving productivity and sustainable practices, noting Nagaland’s yield already surpasses the national average. Experts noted that Nagaland’s average soybean yield of 12.6 quintals per hectare surpasses the national average of 11.79 quintals per hectare, signaling strong growth potential.
