Prime Minister Narendra Modi said that India continues to be a beacon of hope for the world with its strong economy. He said rapid economic development has become the cornerstone for realizing the vision of Viksit Bharat. The Prime minister was addressing a post-budget webinar on the theme Sustaining and Strengthening Economic Growth this morning. The Prime Minister said India has the opportunity to become a key player in becoming a reliable and resilient manufacturing partner for the world. Prime Minister Modi said, government intention and resolve are clear to Build more, produce more, connect more and Export more. He added that early investment in clean technologies will help industries access emerging markets.

The Arunachal Pradesh State Cabinet headed by Chief Minister Pema Khandu approved the creation of fifteen posts under the Arunachal Pradesh Finance & Accounts Service Cadre yesterday. The Cabinet approved the "Draft Arunachal Pradesh Press Accreditation Rules, 2025," to streamline accreditation for journalists and media professionals. The State Cabinet approved five major agendas relating to the Education Department. The Cabinet also Launched "Pakke Declaration Implementation Report-2025". The state Cabinet conveyed its approval for placing five draft bills for consideration in the state's assembly session starting from 6th March. They are related to Transfer and Posting of Employees of Education department, recruitment rules for Physical Education Teachers in secondary level, Grant of Professorship to College Teachers, Recruitment Rules for the Post of Principal and policy for allotment of Diploma, PCM, PCB and Allied seats.

The Deputy Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh, Chowna Mein, convened a Pre-Budget Consultative Meeting with Community-Based Organisations of the State for the ensuing State Budget for the year 2026-27 at the Civil Secretariat, yesterday. Mr Mein emphasised that the pre-budget consultation is not a routine formality but a sincere effort to listen to the voices of the people. The Deputy CM highlighted that youth empowerment and preparing the next generation for emerging opportunities remain central to the Government's vision. The meeting also deliberated on forward-looking initiatives such as the development of heritage villages and cultural tourism models.

The Arunachal Pradesh State Commission for Women, Itanagar will conduct a five-day Jan Sunvai (Public Hearing Programme) from 9th to 13th March 2026 to address grievances of women. The hearings will be held at the APSCW office located at Papu Hill, Papunallah from 10.30 am onwards. Stakeholder departments such as Member from State Legal Services Authority and Police personnel shall take part in the said Jan Sunvai. The Commission further inform that any women suffering or enduring any domestic violence or atrocity can file a complaint letters in the office of the APSCW. The public are also encouraged to attend the Jan Sunvai.

A three-day District Level Training Programme on House listing and Housing Census (Phase-I) under Census of India 2027 is underway at the Golden Jubilee Conference Hall, District Secretariat, Ziro. The training programme is for census officials of Lower Subansiri, Keyi Panyor and Kamle districts. The Census 2027 will be conducted through a 100 per cent digital process. The Census in Arunachal Pradesh will be carried out in two phases — the first phase, Houselisting and Housing Census, will be conducted from 1st May to 30th May 2026, and the second phase, Population Enumeration, will commence from February 2027.

79 out of 86 households of Pangkang (Jorkong) village have signed the MoU with the Government of Arunachal Pradesh, extending their consent for conducting Pre-Feasibility Report-related activities of the Siang Upper Multipurpose Project.

A hardcore insurgent of ULFA (I) faction, self-styled 2nd Lieutenant Bitul Baruha has surrendered in khonsa, Tirap district. Based on credible intelligence inputs from reliable sources regarding the presence of a hardcore insurgent belonging to the ULFA (I) faction in the general area of Horu Chinghan, a focused joint operation was launched by a team comprising Tirap Police, 36 Bn CRPF, and Khonsa Battalion, Assam Rifles at COB Noglo. Sustained pressure and persistent negotiations eventually motivated the insurgent to shun the path of violence and return to the mainstream. During the surrender, one .40 calibre pistol with a magazine and two live rounds of .40 calibre ammunition were recovered.
