President Droupadi Murmu has appointed Governors in different States and Union Territories. Former Bihar Assembly Speaker Nand Kishore Yadav has been appointed as Governor of Nagaland. Lieutenant General (Retired) Syed Ata Hasnain has been appointed as Governor of Bihar. Governor of Tamil Nadu RN Ravi has been appointed as Governor West Bengal. Governor of Kerala Rajendra Vishwanath Arlekar will discharge the functions of Governor of Tamil Nadu. The President has accepted the resignation of Governor of West Bengal Dr. C.V. Ananda Bose. Lieutenant Governor of Ladakh Kavinder Gupta has been appointed as Governor of Himachal Pradesh. Lieutenant Governor of Delhi Vinai Kumar Saxena has been appointed as Lieutenant Governor of Ladakh. Former diplomat Taranjit Singh Sandhu has been appointed as Lieutenant Governor of Delhi. Governor of Himachal Pradesh Shiv Pratap Shukla has been appointed as Governor of Telangana. Telangana Governor Jishnu Dev Varma has been appointed Governor of Maharashtra.

Vice President C P Radhakrishnan is embarking on a three day visit to Nagaland, Mizoram and Tripura starting today. During the visit, the Vice President will grace the 8th Convocation of Nagaland University at Lumami, today. On Saturday, Mr Radhakrishnan will be the Chief Guest at the 20th Convocation of Mizoram University in Aizawl, Mizoram. On his last leg of visit, the Vice President will attend the 14th Convocation of Tripura University in Agartala, Tripura.

In view of the Vice President's visit, Dimapur Police has temporarily declared the area within Chumoukedima District as "Red Zone" or No Fly Zone from 06 AM to 6 PM today. The Police also prohibited use of any kind of Remotely Piloted Aircraft Drones. Further, conduct of any kind of firing practice by Security Forces, Civil Police, Central Police or Private Firing Range or any civilian holder of licensed fire arms and bursting of any kind of firecrackers are also restricted during the same time period.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the 11th edition of Raisina Dialogue in New Delhi yesterday . Delivering the keynote address, President of Finland Dr. Alexander Stubb said the Global South will decide the next world order, and India will play a deciding factor in it.

On shaping the new world order, Dr Stubbs highlighted that India has been applying values based realism for thousands of years. He said this is evident in how India works as a constructive member of the United Nations. Dr Stubbs said, India should have a permanent seat in the UN Security Council. He added that India has been under no illusion and has based its foreign policy on a pragmatic world view. Speaking on the occasion, External Affairs Minister Dr S Jaishankar said Indians must continue to develop sharp global awareness. He said the discussions over the next few days will be about new capabilities, technology, AI and new mindsets.

The theme this year is Samskāra-Assertion, Accommodation, Advancement.
